Award Criteria:

Academic:

- Minimum 2.5 GPA (copy of high school transcript required)
- Proof of enrollment in a 2 or 4-year college (funds will be distributed once enrollment is verified).

Financial Need: (Copy of the following required)

- 2018 tax return exhibiting gross family income, **and**
- EFC form (Estimated Family Contribution) from your FAFSA application

We are willing to consider extenuating circumstances other than financial hardship in our evaluation of the needs of the student.

Other Requirements:

- Scholarship recipients shall report to the Brandon Jackson Scholarship Committee on academic progress during the first two years of study.
 - Local community college students (within 10 miles of Pasadena) shall meet with an assigned mentor at least twice each academic term to discuss classes, grades, and other involvement in college activities.
 - Four-year college students shall submit a written report at the end of each academic term to include classes taken, grades received, and description of other college or extracurricular activities.

Essay: You must complete an essay within the following guidelines:

- A one to two page typed essay
- Essay must address the following: A personal statement that describes your educational and career goals; **emphasizes any obstacles you have overcome** to this point, **your community involvement**, and includes your hopes for the future.

Letters of Recommendation: You must enclose a minimum of **two** letters of recommendation from significant leaders in your life including: teachers or tutors, mentors, coaches and/or pastors or spiritual leaders. We will also consider a recommendation from someone who has known the student for at least four years.

Deadline for application/letters of recommendation is April 7, 2023. Scholarships will be announced at the closing of the 9th Brandon Jackson Scholarship and Basketball Classic taking place May 20, 2023. Awards will be distributed at the BJ Scholarship Award Ceremony (details to follow). Scholarship recipients must be present at announcement and award ceremony.

Scholarship Distribution:

- Scholarship funds shall be distributed as follows:
 - Local community college students will receive one-fourth of the total scholarship amount at the beginning of each major academic term over a two year period.
 - Four-year college students will receive one-half of the total scholarship amount at the beginning of the first and second year of study. This schedule may be altered to deal with individual situations of financial need.
